

COPPA Form for Verifiable Parental Consent

(Children's Online Privacy Protection Act)

Dear Parents,

Mitchell School District utilizes several computer software applications and web-based services, operated not by Mitchell Schools, but by third parties. These include Dropbox, Kindle, Amazon, Overdrive, Google Apps for Education, and similar educational programs.

In order for our students to use these programs and services, certain personal identifying information, generally the student's name and email address must be provided to the web site operator. Under federal law, these websites must provide parental notification and obtain parental consent before collecting personal information from children under the age of 13.

The law permits schools such as Mitchell to consent to the collection of personal information on behalf of all of its students if parental permission is obtain by the school, thereby eliminating the need for individual parental consent given directly to the web site operator.

This form will constitute consent for the Mitchell School District to provide personal identifying information for your child consisting of first name, last name, email address and username to the following web-operators: Overdrive, Kindle, Amazon, Google Apps for Education, Dropbox, Evernote and to the operators of any additional web-based educational programs and services which the Mitchell School District may add during the upcoming academic year.
